The vestry has had their second Zoom meeting with Canon Clark. She will be here for Holy Eucharist and for a Town Hall Meeting for everyone on Sunday October 2nd. Canon Clark is working on finding an interim who will serve as a Priest-in-charge with the possibility of transitioning to a full-time rector.
